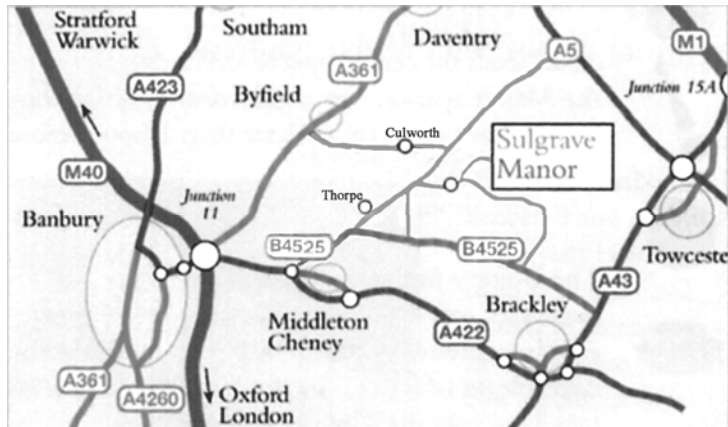


## How to reach Sulgrave Manor By Road from the West



**From BANBURY and Junction 11 of the M40** (about 7 miles): at the roundabout at the motorway junction, follow the signs for the A422 to BRACKLEY. At the next roundabout take the first exit onto the B4525 – there is a brown tourist sign to Sulgrave Manor (SM sign). Follow the B4525, through a crossroads on the outskirts of Middleton Cheney out into country side again. The road begins to climb and there is a 40 mph limit. Road signs indicate a right bend and a left turn just after the bend.

Take the left turn (SM sign) signposted to Thorpe Mandeville and Culworth. Pass through Thorpe Mandeville out into the country again. A sign for a right turn to Sulgrave is positioned in good time – but it comes very soon after another right turn – at almost a 45° angle, signed to Marston. The turn you want is at roughly 95° opposite a house on the left bearing an advert for the Star Inn.

This road brings you into Sulgrave with houses on both sides of the street, gentle bends leading, just after the village shop on the left, to a junction with a small triangular green with tree (SM sign) at which you turn left down Manor Road. The entrance to the Manor's Car Park is clearly marked on the right at the bottom of the road before it bends right.

## How to reach Sulgrave Manor By Road from the East

**From Junction 15a of the M1 and the North via A43** (about 12 miles): follow the A43 south towards OXFORD. After the junction with the A5, go straight across the next roundabout still towards Oxford. There is a fairly long stretch with minor signed exits but watch for the brown tourist sign for Sulgrave Manor which is in good time for the B4525 exit and...

**From the South on the A43** heading towards Northampton  
Be on the look out for exits signed for Brackley – there are three of them and then another signed for Radford. Take the NEXT exit on to the B4525 signed for Banbury and Sulgrave. At the top of the exit, turn left on to the B4525 and....

....Follow the B4525, a few miles past Greatworth, until the next tourist sign, just after a sign for a Blind Summit, tells you to turn right. Continue to the end of this road. Turn right and immediately right again following Sulgrave Manor sign. This road brings you into Sulgrave with houses on both sides of the street, gentle bends leading, just after the village shop on the left, to a junction with a small triangular green with tree (with a brown tourist sign) at which you turn left down Manor Road. The entrance to the Manor's Car Park is clearly parked on the right at the bottom of the road.

**From the A5** : despite the impression on the map, this a route for drivers seeking a quiet, winding lane drive! Others are recommended to take the A43 from the North route above. Villages, quite well signed, are Maidford, Adstone, Canons' Ashby and Moreton Pinkney.
